Using the diaries of three women in San Francisco—Annie Haskell, Ella Lees Leigh, and Mary Eugenia Pierce, who wrote extensively on their everyday experiences—Sewell studies their accounts of day trips to the city and combines them with memoirs, newspapers, maps, photographs, and her own observations of the buildings that exist today to build a sense of life in San Francisco at this pivotal point in history.

Working at the nexus of urban history, architectural history, and cultural geography, *Women and the Everyday City* offers a revealing portrait of both a major American city during its early years and the women who shaped it—and the country—for generations to come.
